You will call to me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart.

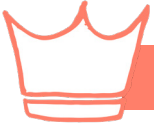

## SESSION 2



Before you read...

- ▶ This week, we are going to read a short passage that shows that Jesus is the Messiah.



Read Luke 7: 11-12

- ▶ Who was with Jesus in the town called Nain?

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- ▶ Who did Jesus see when he approached the town gate?

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- ▶ How do you think this woman, a widow who now also lost her only son, felt?

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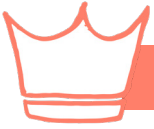
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### Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus encountered a woman, a widow, whose only son had also just died. A large crowd was with Jesus and a large crowd was with the woman.



### Read Luke 7:13

- ▶ How did Jesus feel when He saw the woman?

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- ▶ What did Jesus say to the woman?

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- ▶ What does this one verse tell us about who Jesus is?

## SESSION 2



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus had compassion on the woman who lost her son and told her not to cry. Jesus is full of love and compassion for people, especially those who are grieving.



Read Luke 7:14

- ▶ What did Jesus do in this verse?

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- ▶ What did Jesus say in this verse?

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- ▶ Imagine you were in the crowd, what would you have been thinking?

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## Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus touched the coffin. This was a big deal because the coffin was “unclean” and touching it would make Jesus “unclean” according to the laws of the Old Testament.
- ▶ But, Jesus is God. He has the power to raise the dead and give new life through his holiness.



## Read Luke 7:15

- ▶ What happened to the dead man?

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- ▶ How do you think his mother responded?

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- ▶ Jesus gave this man new life. How can you experience new life in Jesus?

## SESSION 2



### Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that the dead man came back to life. This was the first time Jesus raised someone from the dead. Jesus has the power to bring the dead to life, both someone who has physically died like this man and those who are dead in their sins.
- ▶ Jesus will give us new life in Him if we repent of our sins and trust in Him!



### Read Luke 7:16-17

- ▶ How did the large crowd of people respond to this miracle?

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- ▶ Do you think the crowd told anyone else about this miracle? Why or why not?

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- ▶ If you have trusted in Jesus, you have new life just like this man! Who can you tell about your new life?

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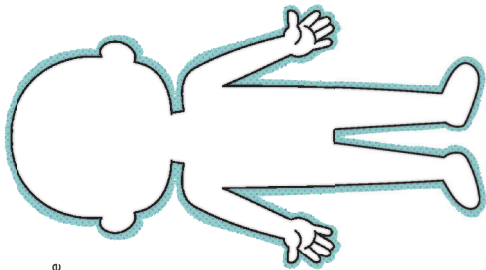

## Before you read...

- ▶ Last week, we read that Jesus gave a man new life by bringing him back from the dead. We know that we also can have new life in Jesus when we ask Him to forgive our sins.
- ▶ This week, we will read about Jesus giving a woman new life by forgiving her sins.



## Read Luke 7:36-38

- ▶ Whose house was Jesus at?

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- ▶ What was the woman doing to Jesus?

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- ▶ What kind of woman was she?

## SESSION 2



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus was at the house of a Pharisee, one of the religious leaders. While He was there, a sinful woman wet His feet with her tears, wiped them with her hair, kissed them, and poured perfume on them! These seem like strange actions!



Read Luke 7:39-40

- ▶ What did the Pharisee think of this woman's actions?

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- ▶ Did the Pharisee speak his thoughts out loud?

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- ▶ Do you think Jesus knew the Pharisee's thoughts?

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## SESSION 2

Wednesday,  
August 12



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that the Pharisee could not believe that Jesus was allowing a sinful woman to touch Him. Jesus is about to teach the Pharisee an important lesson.



Read Luke 7:41-43

- ▶ What did Jesus tell a story about?

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- ▶ Who did Simon say would love the moneylender more?

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- ▶ Have you ever owed someone something? What was it?

## SESSION 2



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read Jesus' parable about two people who owed money. The person who owed more money would definitely be more excited about not having to pay his debt.



Read Luke 7:44-47

- ▶ What did Simon NOT do for Jesus?

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- ▶ What did Jesus say about the woman's sins?

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- ▶ Is a person ever too sinful to come to Jesus?

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### Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus told Simon that the woman loved Him so much because she had been forgiven of so much.
- ▶ Everyone owes God a debt for their sin that they cannot repay. Thankfully, Jesus died and rose again to pay the price so that we can be forgiven if we repent and believe in Him.



### Read Luke 7:48-50

- ▶ What did Jesus say to the woman?

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- ▶ How did the other guests respond?

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- ▶ Have you ever been tempted to look down on others and think you are better than them, like Simon did in this passage? How can we make sure we don't think of others like that?

## SESSION 4



Before you read...

- ▶ This week, we are going to learn from Jesus about prayer.



Read Luke 11:1-4

- ▶ What did the disciples ask Jesus to do?

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- ▶ Have you ever heard of the prayer Jesus taught them? What do we call it?

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- ▶ What kinds of things should we pray about when we pray? (Look at Jesus' example for the answer.)

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## Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read what we call, "The Lord's Prayer." This is the example Jesus used to teach His disciples how to pray. This prayer praises God, confesses sin, and asks for the things we need.
- ▶ Today, we will read a parable, or a story, Jesus used to teach the disciples more about prayer.



## Read Luke 11:5-8

- ▶ What is the friend asking for in the story?  

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- ▶ Why will the friend NOT get up to answer the request?  

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- ▶ What WILL make the friend get up to answer the request?

## SESSION 4



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read a parable that Jesus told His disciples. In the story, Jesus said boldness will help the man get what he needs. Today, we will read Jesus' explanation of the story.



Read Luke 11:9-10

- ▶ What happens when a person asks?

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- ▶ What happens when a person seeks?

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- ▶ What happens when a person knocks?

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## Before you read...

- ▶ With the parable Jesus told the disciples, He was teaching them about persistence in prayer—to pray and not give up. God is a good Father who will give His people what they need.



## Read Luke 11:11-13

- ▶ Has your dad ever given you a snake or a scorpion instead of a good gift?

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- ▶ What kind of gifts does Jesus say parents usually give their children?

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- ▶ Who is even more powerful and can give greater gifts than your parents?

## SESSION 4



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus used the parable of parents giving their children good gifts to show that we can trust God to answer the prayers of His children in ways that are right and good.
- ▶ Today, we are skipping ahead to Luke 18 to read one more parable about prayer. In this parable, Jesus taught that the most important prayer we will ever pray is to tell God that we have sinned and to ask Him to forgive us.



Read Luke 18:10-14

- ▶ What did the Pharisee pray about?

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- ▶ What did the tax collector pray about?

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- ▶ Why is it important to pray with humility?

### **Memory Verse: Jeremiah 29:12-13**

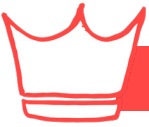

## SESSION 5



Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read that Jesus said we should guard against all kinds of greed because our life is not about how many possessions we have.



Read Luke 12:16-21

- ▶ What did the man do with his extra crops?

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- ▶ What would have been a better thing for the man to do with his extra crops?

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## Before you read...

- ▶ Yesterday, we read about a “fool” who stored up all of his crops just for himself instead of being rich toward God and sharing with others.
- ▶ Jesus continues to teach about worrying about your possessions in today’s passage.

- ▶ What does Jesus say not to worry about?

Before you read...

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- ▶ Where will our heart be?

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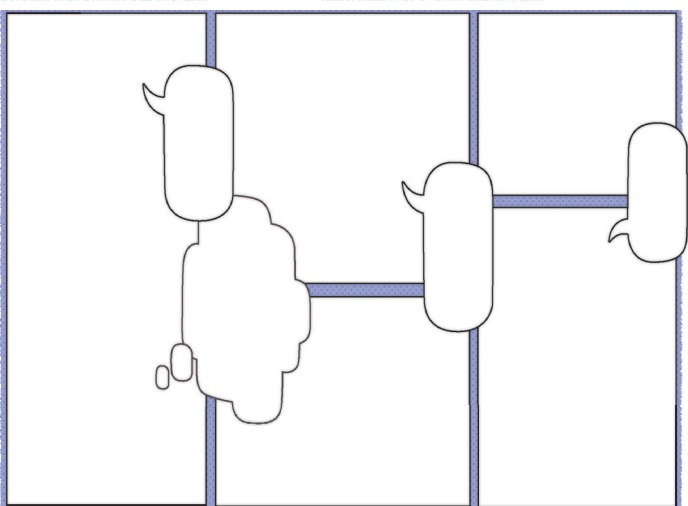
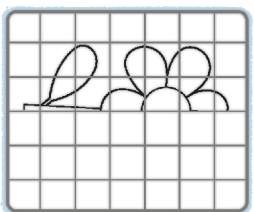
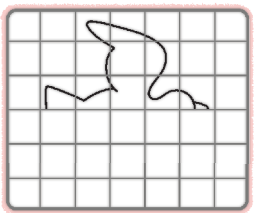
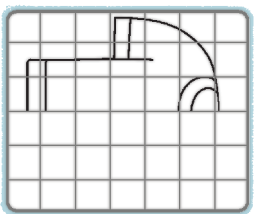
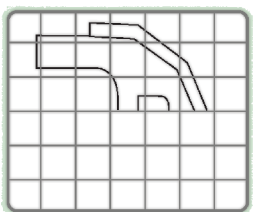
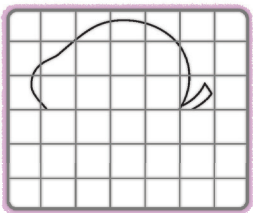
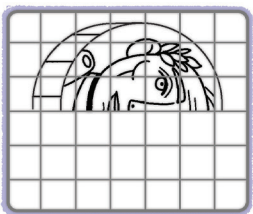
