The Hope Community Development Association (Hope CDA) construction jobs training program focuses on skills needed to be successful in the construction industry and in all of life, helping men become financially self-sufficient and to mold them into leaders in their workplace, their neighborhoods and their families.

SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

Coach/Mentor - Meet weekly to encourage and help the men set goals.

Teach life skills - On Fridays from 7 - 9 AM, men watch and discuss a video series about authentic manhood from a biblical perspective. The second hour is spent on budgeting, love, forgiveness, relationships, etc.

- Work alongside the men at construction job sites -This is about relationship building and discipleship. Work is usually handyman type jobs – painting, dry walling, etc. Instructions and training are provided.
- Contractors, electricians, and plumbers - can be retired.
- Program Manager - find or create curriculum for teaching skills.
