OUR TIPS

PRAY

Pray for your student daily and ask God to help them process sexuality from God’s perspective.

ASK QUESTIONS

Ask your student specific open-ended questions about sexuality often.

BE INFORMED

Make sure that you are aware of the current issues and process the information as if you were in your student’s shoes.

INITIATE CONVERSATIONS

Initiate and keep the conversation going over the course of their HS experience.
